Introducing Our Newest Board Member: Vivian Frost, HASSDA Secretary



Five years ago, I happened to be on the Plaza during Coffeyville's Dalton Defender Days and saw the Coffeyville, Kansas, Promenade Club square dancing. I did not know that people still square danced. They

caught my attention and when they took a break, they handed out cards about their new lessons beginning. I had just changed positions at work and my new job was sitting at a desk, so I had been looking for exercise classes, but they were all during the day while I was at work. I am not a dancer; my right and left feet do not cooperate. I thought it might be a fun way to get some exercise. I am a little shy, so I was nervous about going somewhere when I would not know anyone there and I talked myself into and out of going until it was time for the lessons. I followed that up with Advance lessons because one of our dancers asked me to try it just one time. I loved the challenge and can do either side. I imagine that if I have a chance to try to learn Challenge one

day, I will. Lately, I have been trying to learn to call. I have a long way to go, but I joined CALLERLAB this summer. I hope to teach my first beginning square dance class this spring.

Square dancers have become family, and I try to do my part to keep square dancing alive in our area. Even though I work full-time, most weeks I attend dances or workshops four to seven days a week, most of it driving up to an hour and a quarter to get there. I dance regularly in Joplin, MO, Tulsa and Claremore, OK, and Chanute and Coffeyville, KS. I am Vice-President of the Coffeyville, KS, Promenade Club, President of the Claremore, OK, Will Rogers Squares, and 2nd Vice-President of Northeast Oklahoma Square Dance Association. I attended the National Square Dance Conventions in Evansville, Mobile, and Milwaukee, I am signed up for Shreveport, and I am already looking forward to going to Waco and Loveland. I will be retiring February 1 and I look forward to being able to travel to more dances as well as volunteering for disaster response, or other things I have not had the opportunity to do in the past.

I am excited and looking forward to learning my duties as HASSDA's secretary. I have been to four HASSDA festivals and had a fun time at all of them.

I made up my mind that I wanted to win Friday so I could dance with anyone I wanted to on Saturday.

What fun I had as I danced the day and night away with people I knew and many new people, both guys and gals. I love it when someone leaves my square and says I want to dance in your square again because you have so much fun! Some of my partners taught me new things and moves. I'm a spinner so it was fun when I was spun around.

When the time was called Friday night I had ended up setting a new record by dancing with 35 different people and won my 'golden' ticket to next year's dance!

I LOVE my square dancing family and seeing faces of friends that I have danced with at the many dances I try to get to. I haven't attended a dance yet where there isn't someone that I have met before. I'm hoping that square dancing is having a revival and we can increase our clubs and callers. I feel it is so good for us not only physically (at a festival I can get over 20 miles on my pedometer in a day), but also mentally and socially. After the death of my spouse it has given me a great outlet for socializing and I do LOVE me some YELLOW ROCKS!
